Point One: God Grieves Insincere Service In His Name

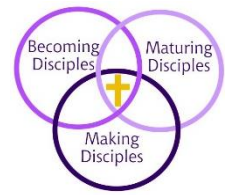
Point Two: Genuine Repentance Leads to Genuine Fellowship With God....and With Others
